ABOUT TÜRKİYE

Türkiye, officially the Republic of Türkiye, is a transcontinental country located mainly on the Anatolian Peninsula in Western Asia, with a smaller portion in the Balkans in Southeast Europe. It shares borders with Greece and Bulgaria to the northwest, the Black Sea to the north, Georgia to the northeast, Armenia, Azerbaijan (Nakhchivan), and Iran to the east, Iraq to the southeast, and Syria and the Mediterranean Sea to the south. The Aegean Sea lies to the west, and Cyprus is situated off the southern coast.

The capital city is Ankara, while Istanbul is the country's largest city and main economic and cultural hub. Türkiye has a diverse climate: coastal areas enjoy a temperate Mediterranean climate with hot, dry summers and mild, wet winters, whereas the interior experiences a more continental climate with greater seasonal variation.



3. Table Tennis Technical Rules

In general, the EUC Table Tennis will employ the technical rules of the International Table Tennis Federation (ITTF) with EUSA.

4. Championship Format

The championship will include 6 events:

- Team event for men and women
- Singles event for men and women
- Doubles event for men and women

5. Number of Athletes

• There must be a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 5 players in a team, and 2 officials from one university.

6. Number of Teams

A maximum of 24 women's teams and a maximum of 24 men's teams can participate in the championship.

Each NUSA can enter 3 women's teams and 3 men's teams. The teams listed by NUSA as number 1 will enter in the first order. The teams listed with number 2 will be entered in the second order in case of free places. The teams listed with number 3 will be entered in the third order in case of free places.

The teams consist of players representing a university.

7. Program / Playing Scheme

The championship will take place in 5 days, based on the following program:

1st day – qualification rounds of men's and women's team events;

2nd day – continuation of men's and women's team events;

3rd day – final rounds of men's and women's team events; men's and women's singles events;

4th day – men and women singles events; men and women doubles events;

5th day – final rounds of men's and women's singles events; final rounds of men's and women's doubles events.

Playing mode (scheme)

Only the players of the team can participate in the single and double events. Team event

A maximum of 24 teams can participate in the event.

Seeding of the teams shall be determined by the previous championship and EUSA ranking. If two or three universities from the same country are entered in the event, they shall be placed in different groups.

The matches will be played in the system "best of five".

The two best teams from each group advance to the off, where the matches will be played in the best-of-five playoff system.

The teams will not play for the following places (3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17).

Singles event

The event will be played in a play-off system for competitors. All the players who entered the Championship can participate. In case there are more than 64 players, preliminary rounds shall be organized.

Only the players from the world ranking of ITTF shall be seeded up to 16.

Wherever practical, players from the same country or university shall be placed in different quarters or halves of the draw.

Doubles event

The event will be played in a play-off system. A double can consist only of two players from the same university team.

The team event draw will be held in the meeting hall of the Burdur Lavander Hill Hotel, the day before the competition begins. Heads of Delegations must attend the draw.

- The Chief Referee of the championship with the appropriate experience shall be appointed by the organizers.
- Organizers are responsible for appointing the umpires for all the matches.

<u>Oth</u>er

The ranking provided by EUSA for NUSA will take into account the results obtained in the team event.

A training facility must be made available for all the competitors at least 1 day before the start of the competition.

In case of any unresolved matters, the final decision will be taken by a SCAC member together with the Chief Referee of the Championship in accordance with the rules of ITTF.

10. Appealing Committee Regulation

Protest on non-technical matters

If any protest goes beyond the responsibilities of the referee or umpire, the SCAC shall hold a meeting to make a decision regarding the complaint.

Protest on technical matters

Any protest must be made to the EUSA technical delegate, who will forward it to the SCAC.

Each head of delegation can protest against a decision. The protest must be in written form and accompanied by a deposit of 200 Euros, which will be returned in case the protest is accepted.

The decision is final and must be communicated to the head of the delegation of the university concerned.

11. Table Tennis Venue

The EUSA European Universities Table Tennis Championship 2025 will be hosted at the state-of-the-art MAKÜ Sports Complex, located within the campus of Burdur Mehmet Akif Ersoy University (MAKÜ). In the tournament, Joola Flash 40+ white balls, KBS 25-2 Match Tables, and Gerflor gray flooring will be used. This modern and versatile facility offers top-tier conditions for both athletes and spectators.

Main Sports Hall


The championship matches will take place in the sports hall, which features: PVC flooring, ideal for high-level table tennis competition 2,200 seating capacity for spectators







15. Medical Treatment

The organizer will arrange medical assistance at the event. Please remember to be fully insured (international card) as all hospital treatments are subject to payment.

The organizer does not cover ANY medical treatment during your stay in Burdur. It is mandatory to have your insurance with you.



ANTI-DOPING

Doping is not a guarantee of success in sport. In fact, its effect is usually the opposite. A lot of elite sportsmen and sportswomen who did doping got caught. As a result, they lost pride and were banned for at least 2 years from participating in a sport they loved and lived for. An even bigger problem of doping are the effects on the body.

In elite sports, doping is defined as a violation of one or more anti-doping rules:

- 1. Presence of a prohibited substance in an athlete's sample
- 2. Use or attempted use of a prohibited substance or method
- 3. Refusing to submit a sample collection after being notified
- 4. Failure to file athlete whereabouts information & missed tests
- 5. Tampering with any part of the doping control process
- 6. Possession of a prohibited substance or method
- 7. Trafficking a prohibited substance or method
- 8. Administering or attempting to administer a prohibited substance or method to an athlete

You can find the list of prohibited substances and methods on the internet, as it is updated every year by the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) and it's valid for every sport.

EUSA is active in Anti-Doping promotion, and has been a partner in the European Anti-Doping Initiative (EADIn) and Match point, supporting European-wide Anti-Doping mentality in the youth sector by establishing a moral tenor towards concepts such as Fair-play, sensitizing and raising awareness on all levels of the complex social environment surrounding the doping problematic, and implementing strategies to motivate young people to pass on the message and create a strong multiplying effect. Also, the International University Sport Federation (FISU) has been actively promoting sports without drugs, also at the university sports level.

EUSA is currently not enforcing doping tests at our events. In accordance with the national legislation of the host countries, however, doping controls may be implemented by the National Anti-Doping Agencies. If such doping tests are executed, the WADA rules and regulations are applicable to all athletes. Please remember that testing can be conducted in-competition and out-of-competition. If you are identified in a Registered Testing Pool (RTP), you must provide current and accurate whereabouts information.

FAİR-PLAY

Fair play is a core value of EUSA, deeply embedded in our mission and activities. In partnership with the European Fair Play Movement(EFPM), we actively promote sportsmanship, respect, and solidarity at all our events. For over 20 years, EUSA has championed these values, recognising fair play as the true essence of sport.

Fair play is present in sports as the unwritten rule, a moral value that represents the real essence of sport. It represents that the opponent must be appreciated, and nowadays, in the practice of sports, more than ever, it is vitally important to defend the values intrinsic to sport respect for oneself and others, solidarity, and fair play.

Since 2007, EUSA has honouredoutstanding acts of fair play with the Enno HarmsFair Play Award, named after our first President and a strong advocate for fair play. At each event, organisers, delegates, and participants commit to upholding fair play, with the oath of respect and integrity declared during the opening ceremonies.

The prestigious annual EUSA Enno Harms Fair Play Awardis awarded to athletes demonstrating

fair play during the matches, following the rules, and pursuing a "clean" game, and is awarded with a fair play recognition already during the event. EUSA Executive Committee members discuss the proposals received from all sporting events governed by EUSA in that year and select the team or individual to receive the Enno Harms Fair Play award, which is formally handed to them at a special occasion, usually at the EUSA Gala.



Fair play will remain a key focus at the European Universities Championships 2025.

Guided by EUSA's principles and the Olympic spirit, our events promote respect, equality, and non-discrimination, contributing to a more inclusive and peaceful society through sport.

We kindly invite all delegations to submit proposals for the Enno Harms Fair Play Award, recognising individuals or university teams who have demonstrated exemplary behavior, integrity, and sportsmanship during the Championships.

One of the Fundamental Principles of Olympism is that "practice of sport is a human right" and that "every individual must have the possibility of practising sport, without discrimination of any kind". This principle further states that this requires a behaviour based on "mutual understanding with a spirit of friendship, solidarity and fair play".

EUSA considers sports as an active tool in the education of university students and aims at encouraging and supporting "the promotion of ethics, Fair Play, genderequity and good governance in sport" (EUSA Statutes).

With the EUSA Incident Policy, EUSA clarifies the expectations and consequences regarding the behaviour of different stakeholders at EUSA's events to allow the creation of a safe and enjoyable environment.
